Dear Parent:

With your permission, the Kern County Elections Office would like to invite your son or daughter to volunteer as a Student Poll Worker for the upcoming election.

Students who are selected to work at a polling site are required to attend the mandatory 3 hour training course prior to Election Day. We provide training throughout Kern County both during the week and also weekends. Students will serve with 4 to 5 other members of our community on a precinct board. Poll worker participation is an exciting all-day event. Students are expected to be present at the polling place from 6 a.m. to approximately 2 hours after poll close at 8 p.m. on Election Day plus on Monday prior to the election for site set-up for approximately 1-2 hours, time to be arranged by Supervisor. Students are responsible for providing their own transportation to and from training and the polling site on Election Day. For the convenience of both students and parents, students are assigned to a polling place in close proximity to their home or school.

In addition to gaining an invaluable learning experience about the democratic process, students are paid \$110 stipend for serving on Election Day and an additional \$10 for attending a training class. Payment is mailed approximately 4-6 weeks following the election.

Rewards of being a Student Poll Worker include:

- ★ Hands-on introduction to the democratic process
- ★ Students can earn community service hours (check with your school for their policy)
- ★ Students are more likely to become lifelong voters
- ★ Students can earn \$120
- ★ Volunteerism looks great on college and scholarship applications and resumes
- ★ Students gain satisfaction from helping out their community

In order for your student to be assigned on Election Day review the additional requirements on the Student Poll Worker application on the reverse side of this letter, complete the application, and obtain parent and teacher signatures, then return it to Kern County Elections Office. If for some reason your student is unable to participate after being placed on a precinct, please have your student call our office immediately.
