# By signing this Adopt-A-Poll application:

- ★ You agree to comply with California and Kern County Election Laws including attending of the mandatory poll worker training course.
- ★ You certify that you are a U.S. citizen and registered to vote in California, or a legal permanent resident of the United States.
- ★ You certify that you can read and write in the English language.
- ★ You understand that, as a poll worker, you serve at the will of the Kern County Registrar of Voters and may be removed with, or without, cause.
- ★ You understand that you may not be selected to work every election or in your home precinct.
- ★ You may agree to donate your paid stipend to your organization. If you decide to do so, you should make arrangements with the organization to donate the money.

## **POLL WORKER POSITIONS**

### Inspector:

Responsible for his/her precinct in addition to receiving and checking supplies, oversees the clerks assigned to the precinct, verifies the poll workers are trained and prepared to open the poll site on Election Day. Ensures supplies and ballots are accounted for and properly returned to the Collection Center. MUST ensure that a cell phone is available for the precinct.

### Clerk:

Work as assigned by the Site Supervisor, Supervisor-Inspector or Inspector. Performs tasks such as finding voters' names on the roster, issuing and receiving official ballots, and assisting voters in any phase of the voting process.

### ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) Set-up Clerk:

Set-up and take-down directional signage and modification items to ensure the poll site conforms to ADA accessibility requirements. This position can be worked in conjunction with any of the above positions.
